## Salvation is All of Christ!

Any so-called "gospel" that leaves the ultimate decision and/or work of complete salvation up to the sinner, or to rest upon the sinner's works or decision, is no gospel at all. Considering the state and condition of sinners here on earth, according to God's Word (*Rom. 3:10-20; 1 Cor. 2:14; Eph. 2:13*), it would not be "good" news. By nature, we have no ability to put away our sins or make ourselves qualified or righteous before God, no power to give ourselves spiritual life, no will to believe in Christ by faith or to repent of our dead works and idolatry, and no strength to persevere in faith. This is all the work of Christ for and in His people whom the Father gave to Him before the world began (*John 6:37-45*).

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross in fulfillment of all the requirements and conditions of the everlasting covenant of grace, sometimes called the covenant of redemption. It was absolutely impossible that an innocent person—absolutely considered as such—should suffer under the sentence and curse of the law, for the law could pronounce no punishment on any such person. Guilt and punishment are related; where guilt is absent, condemnation cannot be. It was because the Holy One of God was made guilty, meaning as He stood Surety and Substitute of God’s elect and by their sins being imputed to Him, that He could righteously be punished in their place. Yet even that had not been possible unless the spotless Substitute had first assumed the office of suretyship; and that, in turn, was only legally valid because of Christ being the Representative (High Priest) of His people, God’s elect given to Him before the foundation of the world. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ owes all its validity from the covenant: the holy and blessed Trinity, by counsel and oath, having appointed Him and His finished work on the cross to be the true and only propitiation (sin-bearing sacrifice accomplishing satisfaction) for sin —Copied
