Hereby we cease trying to be saved by our works and rest in HIS work for us, His righteousness alone which God has imputed to us (Heb. 4:9-10). Christ is our continual and eternal Sabbath. We must fight the fleshly, self-righteous urge to work our way into God's favor and earn His blessings and rest in Christ Who gained all grace here and all glory hereafter for us (Heb. 4:11; cf. Matt. 11:28-30). —Pastor Bill Parker
